# Individual Consultant to develop a policy and regulatory framework for Recycled PET (RPET) for Uganda

### BACKGROUND

The Natural Resources Stewardship Programme (NatuReS) is a global GIZ programme that promotes multi-stakeholder collective action for the sustainable management of natural resources by enabling public-private-civil society partnerships to address shared natural resource threats for improved livelihoods and continued economic development. NatuReS is funded by the European Union (EU), the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and the UK Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO), and is implemented by GIZ through Uganda's Ministry of Water and Environment.

The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area (GKMA) PET Plastic Recycling Partnership is a multi-stakeholder partnership under NatuReS. This partnership is comprised of Coca Cola Bottlers Africa, Mukwano Group of Companies, Uganda Water & Juice Manufacturers Association, National Environment Management Agency (NEMA), Kampala Capital City Authority (KCCA), Ministry of Water and Environment and Global Green Growth Institute. The key objective of the partnership is to improve the sustainable management of PET plastic waste in GKMA through developing an inclusive green recycling sector.

The population in GKMA is rapidly increasing and urban solid waste generated is following a similar trend. However, only a fraction of this waste currently ends up in designated landfills with the rest ending up in natural systems. Evidently, the most poorly disposed-off waste in GKMA is Polyethylene terephthalate (PET) plastic. Recycling of PET is one of the measures in practice to mitigate public health and environmental threats from poor management of PET plastic waste. However, Uganda's PET recycling sector is currently constrained by challenges that necessitate the presence of an enabling policy and regulatory environment for recycled PET (RPET).

### OBJECTIVE OF THIS ASSIGNMENT

The development of a policy and regulatory framework for recycled PET for Uganda that will provide an improved enabling environment for the PET recycling sector. This framework will be presented to Government of Uganda through its representatives in the partnership.

### Eligibility criteria

Assessment will be done on pass/fail basis. Non-compliant bids will be eliminated.

The consultant will be required to present an Individual TIN, National

ID/Passport, Work permit for non-Ugandans, Employer's no objection letter (for appraisers with public or private employment contracts) and Bid validity period of 120 working days.
